Sealed bids will be received by the Township Clerk for the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Caldwell, on Thursday, December 27, 2012 at 10:00 AM, prevailing time, or soon after as the matter can be reached, in the Conference Room, Municipal Building, 30 Clinton Road, West Caldwell, New Jersey, at which time and place bids will be opened and read in public for:

**RICHARD AVENUE & FRANKLIN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENTS**

The work generally consists of RICHARD AVENUE & FRANKLIN AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENTS including but not limited to:

1. 2950 L.F. – 8" CLDIP, Class 53
2. 295 L.F. – 8" CLDIP, Class 53, as directed
3. 49 Units – 1" Residential Services, Type 'K'
4. 6 Units – Hydrant Assemblies

Deduct Alternate #1 – **Use** 2950 L.F., 8" PVC Water Main, 200 PSI Pressure Class **instead of** 2950 L.F. – 8" CLDIP, Class 53.

Deduct Alternate #2 – **Use** 295 L.F., 8" PVC Water Main, 200 PSI Pressure Class as directed **instead of** 295 L.F. – 8" CLDIP, Class 53, as directed.

The Plans, Specifications and Form of Proposal prepared by the Township Engineer, are on file in the office of the Township Engineer, Omland Engineering Associates, 54 Horsehill Road, Cedar Knolls, New Jersey, where same may be inspected and copies obtained for a non-refundable document fee \$150.00 made payable by check to Omland Engineering Associates.

Bids must be submitted on a standard Form of Proposal. Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder on the face of the envelope and clearly marked with the name of the contract being bid. Bids must be submitted at the time and place above specified and will be opened and read immediately thereafter. Bids will be accepted by mail or in person, however, no bid will be accepted after the date and hour specified. In the case of mailed bids, the Township assumes no responsibility for bid proposals received after the date and time specified.

The Mayor and Council reserve the right to waive any informality and reject any and all bids. Bidders shall comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 et seq.
