

The Township of West Caldwell will be closely following the directives for opening the pools set out by the New Jersey Department of Health. These include but are not limited to the following:

- **Capacity guidelines will be monitored.**
- **Routine cleaning and disinfecting of frequently touched surfaces several times a day.**
- **Social distancing markers at the entrance, snack bar and restrooms.**
- **Signage indicating COVID-19 protocols.**
- **Staff members will be screened for fever each day. Snack bar staff will be required to wear gloves when handling food.**
- **Occupancy limits will be enforced in restrooms.**
- **Hand sanitizing stations will be available.**
- **A COVID-19 'Ambassador' will be on site each day to monitor and encourage social distancing.**

RULES FOR POOL PATRONS

Swimmers should practice social distancing when in the water, on the pool deck and in common areas. This does not apply to family members, caretakers, household members or romantic partners.

Pool patrons are encouraged to wear a cloth face covering outside of the pool in common areas such as the entrance, snack bar and bathrooms.

Guest passes are suspended for the time being. They will be reconsidered at a later date.

There will be no Lost and Found maintained. Anything left behind will be discarded. If you bring your own chair to the pool, you must remove it daily.

Pool chairs will be available on a first come first serve basis.

Foot coverings must be worn in the restrooms and showers.

You must bring your own basketball, bocce set, volleyball or horseshoes.

Parties will not be permitted this summer.

The pool playground will remain closed until the NJ Health Department lifts the restriction.
