The next step is for each Team member to register with the Recreation Department, either online through Community Pass (<https://register.communitypass.net/westcaldwell>) or you may mail or drop off registration and payment to 30 Clinton Road. You will be asked for your Team name (which you create with your other team members), your Discord user name and your Platform Gamer Tag.

Incidents will be handled how West Caldwell Recreation staff deems appropriate based on the severity of the incident.
