



**Caldwell Environmental Commission Contest
In honor of Earth Day/ Arbor Day 2014
Celebrating the NEW 3 R's: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle**

Prizes are awarded in several different age categories; whoever creates a work that best describes the theme for their age group wins.

Grades K- 2 and Grades 3-5

Theme: Why is it important to recycle? Winners each receives \$25

Middle School – Grades 6-8

Theme: What is e-waste and how do you recycle it? Winner receives \$25

High School – Grades 9-12

Theme: The Science & Benefits of Recycling Winner receives \$40

College and Adult (Caldwell resident)

Theme: How can you persuade people to recycle? Winner receives \$40

Entries may come in any creative form: a poster, essay (no more than 300 words) video, public service announcement, diorama, photo with a description, illustration, a useful collage-type object made from items that would otherwise be thrown out, etc.

Entries must be submitted to the **Caldwell Public Library by Saturday April 25 at noon**, or to the **Caldwell Borough Hall by Friday April 24 at 4:30 p.m.** Include your name, grade, school and phone number.

Entries will be displayed at the Caldwell Borough Hall. Winners will be selected by the Caldwell Environmental Commission and announced at the Recycle Day on May 3 at 11 a.m. All entries will receive a certificate.
